Literacy

Text Focus: What the Ladybird Heard and The Train Ride

- Phase One Phonics Aspect 7.
- Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can: spot and suggest rhymes - count or clap syllables in a word - recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother.
- Hear and say some initial sounds.
- Beginning to orally blend.

Maths

- Fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').
- Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.
- Discuss routes and locations, using words like `in front of' and `behind'.
- Describe a familiar route.

Personal, social and emotional development

- Develop appropriate ways of being assertive.
- Begin to understand how others might be feeling.
- Talk about their feelings using words like `angry' or `worried'.
