What you need

- Kitchen roll tube
- Gaffer tape/ Duct tape
- Small funnel

What to do

- 1. Tape the funnel to one end of the kitchen roll.
- 2. Listen to a friend's chest.
- 3. Can you hear their heart beating?
- 4. Count how many beats in 1 minute.
- 5. Predict what would happen if they did some star jumps for 1 minute.
- 6. Count the number of beats after the exercise.
- 7. Record your answers. What do you notice?
